South Australian Club Baseball

He played for the West Torrens Baseball Club – total senior games 432 including 372 A Grade games. Was A Grade Coach for 8 seasons – 4 Premierships & 3 times Runner up. Kingsley won the A Grade Best & Fairest – 4 times and runner up 3 times. Was awarded Life Membership of WT in 1964 and was named Head Coach of WT Team of the Century in 2000.

He coached the Adelaide Baseball Club 'A' Grade from season 1968-69 for 5 seasons.

South Australian Baseball League

League Chairman – 3 seasons, Vice President – 1 season, President – 5 seasons, Umpires Appointment Panel – 8 seasons, General Manager SABL – 8 Years. Kingsley was awarded League Life Membership in 1975. He was Runner-up in Capps Medal in 1957 & 1959.

Night Baseball League

State Representative as Player – 2 times and was Head Coach – 5 times for 5 titles.

Played for Goodwood Indians in 1952-53 then West Torrens Eagles from 1953-54 to 1963-64 (a playing coach for 5 seasons and then non playing coach for 3 seasons – 1965-66 to 1967-68) and also Woodville Magpies in 1964-65 as Playing Coach. He was the Night Baseball Premiership coach with the West Torrens Eagles on 5 occasions. He was Runner up Shipway Medal in season 1961-62.

SABL Claxton Shield Team

He represented SA as a player in 5 series. He was Head Coach of SA for 12 series – winning coach 5 times and runner up – 2 times. He was named Head Coach of the Claxton Shield 75th Anniversary team in 2009.

Australian Baseball League

Awarded Australian Baseball Federation Life Membership in 1993 and named in the Australian Baseball Hall of Fame in 2005 for his contribution to Coaching.

Australian Team Player – 1959, 1960, 1961, Selected as Australian Coach – 1966, 1967 – no tour, Australian Assistant Coach – 1968 & 1969. Australian Head Coach – 1970, 1971, 1973.

Australian Baseball Council – 4 years, President Australian Baseball Federation – 2 years and Vice President – 6 years.
